

We would like to convey a special thanks to CPS, our technical consultants and sound/lighting providers, who after a lot of consultation and planning, have created a new look to our Convention stage. The photograph above shows the stage setting for the quartet contest. Obviously the pillars will be removed for the chorus contests!

The new Cyclorama cloth, held by specially designed framework, will provide us with a platform for enhanced mood lighting for contest and shows. This "touring" stage can be used wherever we hold convention, so that we can retain a consistency of presentation.
